RSI prevention campaign

As you may have noticed, a new campaign with LEGO figures has started to raise awareness on things you can do to prevent development of RSI. Also, we want to update you on other processes that are going on at our university on this topic. Website: safety.wur.nl

This refers to a Brightspace environment where students are informed about safety issues. You can, for example, follow e-learning screen work (CANS prevention) and safe field work and there are instructional videos on how to set up your workplace. Weekly walk-in hour CANS

Every Wednesday from 3-4 pm, you can go to the walk-in hour in Forum room 30 with questions related to CANS. During this session, students will receive advice about their workplace and any complaints they may have.
