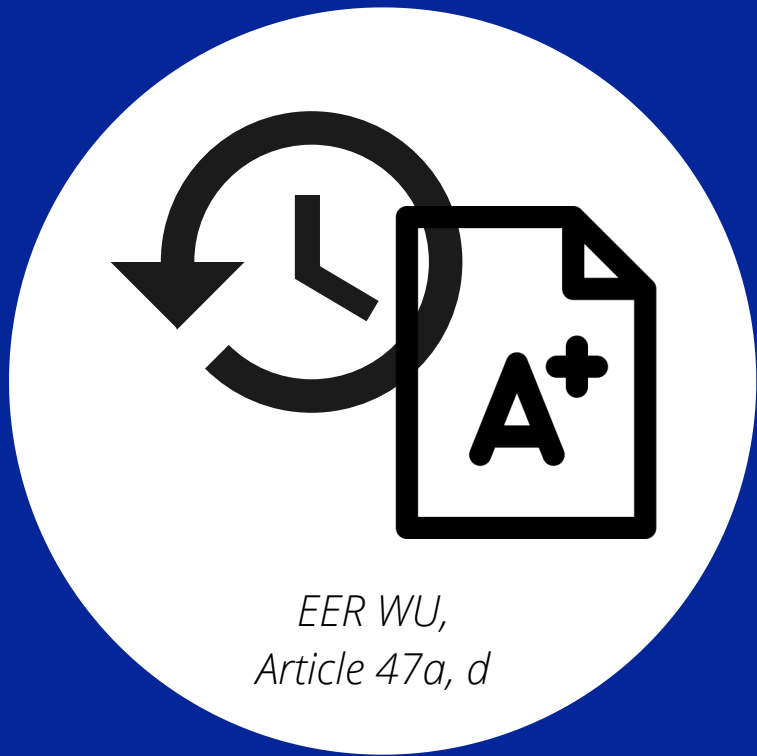


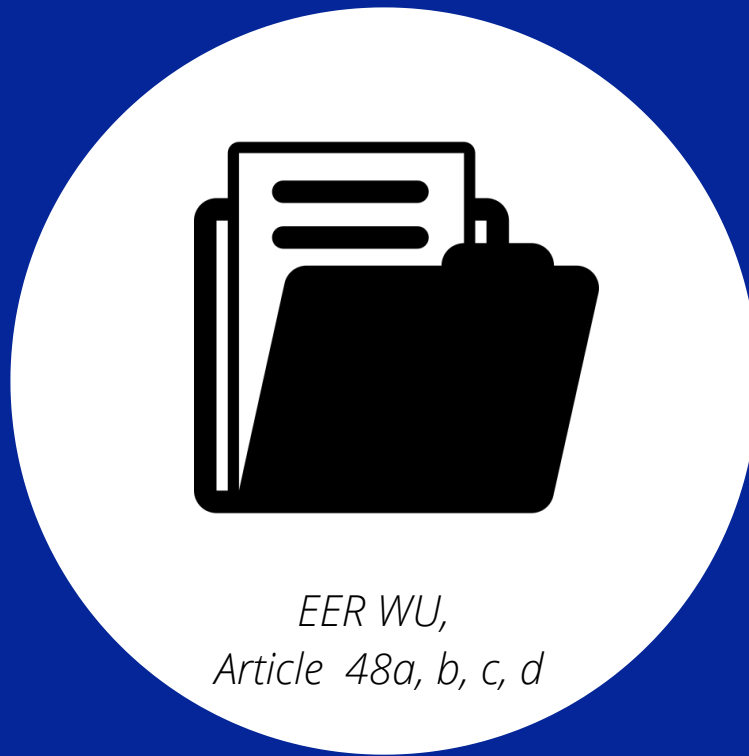

EXAM RESULTS

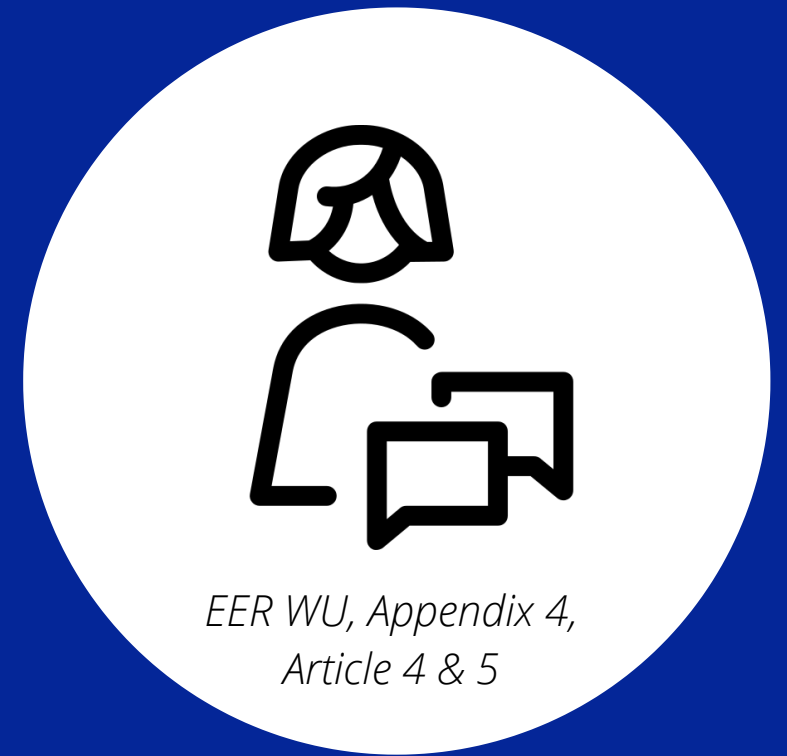
Your exam results should be published within 10 working days after the last day of the exam period.

EXAM INSPECTION

Inspection of your exam should be facilitated within 10 working days after publication of your result. This also accounts for digital exams! If you are prevented from inspecting due to unforeseen circumstances, you can apply for another inspection within 15 working days. An examiner or teacher should always be present during inspection!
